



Finger Puppets

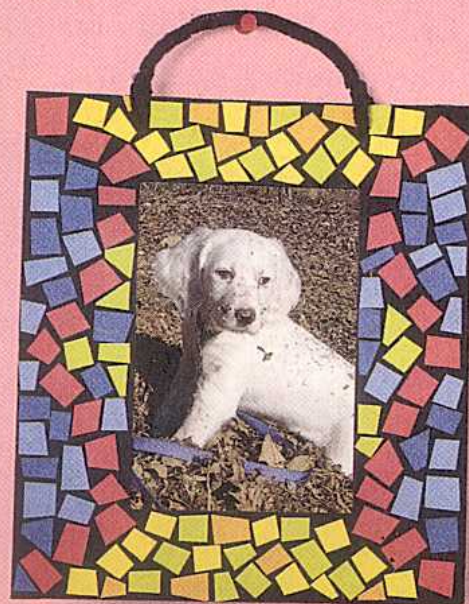
1. For a finger puppet, cut two matching shapes from **craft foam**.
2. Use **chenille sticks** to sew the edges closed, leaving an opening at the bottom.
3. Decorate one side of the puppet with **markers, wiggle eyes, craft-foam pieces, or beads.**
4. Use the finger puppets for a puppet show or as pencil toppers.



Mosaic Picture Frame

1. Cut a 4-inch-by-6-inch window in the center of a **cardboard** rectangle.
2. Paint the cardboard and let it dry.
3. Cut small pieces from **colored paper**. Use a **glue stick** to glue them to the frame.
4. For a hanger, punch two holes near the top, and twist a **chenille stick** through them.
5. Tape a **photo** behind the window.



Build-a-Monster

1. For the monster's head, glue **felt** around a **round cardboard container**.
2. Cut out felt features such as hair, beards, eyebrows, eyes, ears, noses, and teeth.
3. Smooth the features onto the monster's head.
4. Store the extra features inside the monster's head.
